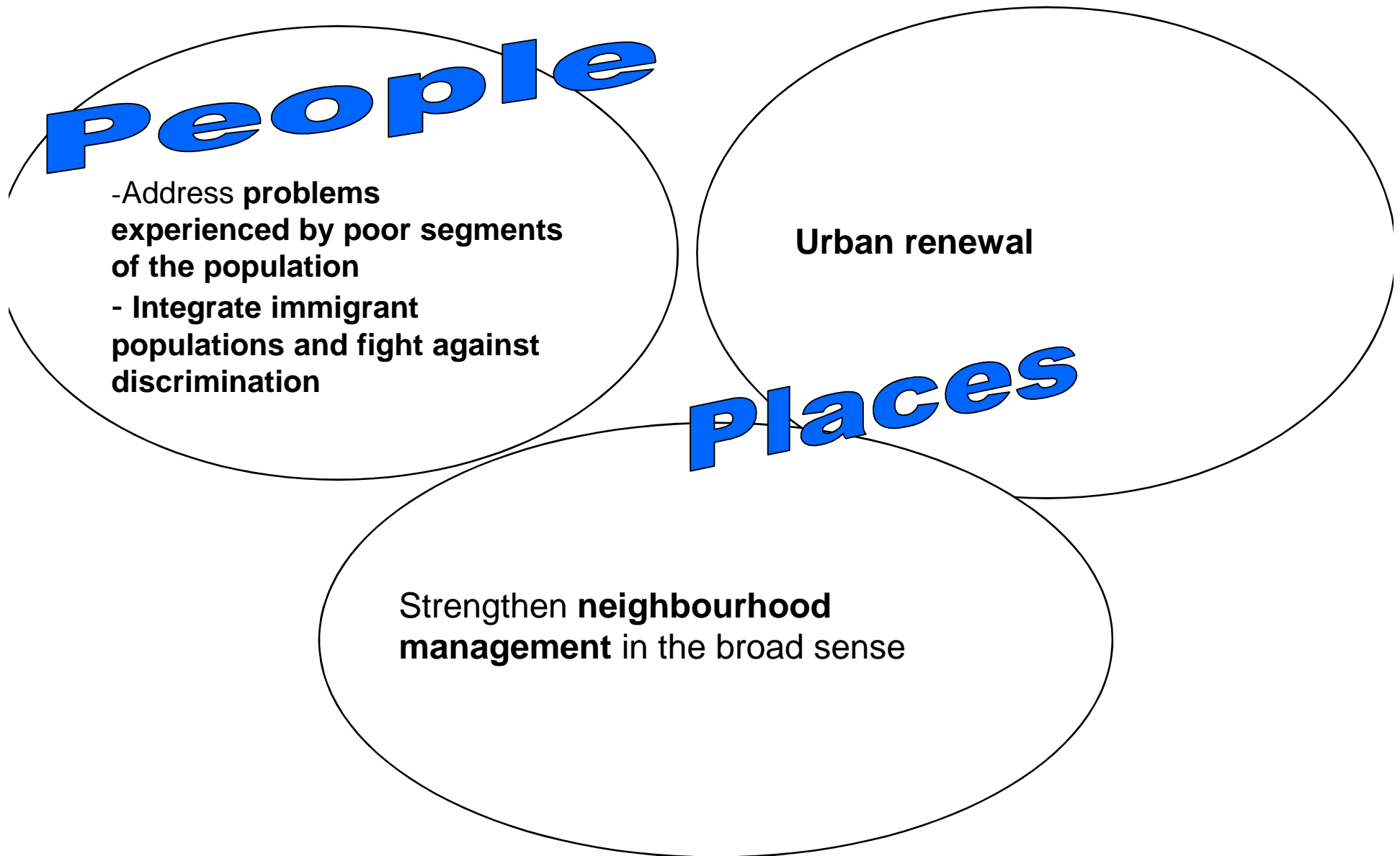
Neighbourhoods and communities in difficulty: three areas of action

- Addressing **social problems experienced by poor segments of the population** (education, employment, etc.)
- **Integrating immigrant populations and fighting discrimination**

- In some cases, **urban renewal** programmes
- demolition/reconstruction work to transform low-income neighbourhoods
 - and to achieve a better balance of poor and rich neighbourhoods across the metropolitan area

Strengthening **neighbourhood management** in the broad sense of the term (maintenance, living environment, safety, neighbourly relations, etc.)
